Your dancer should arrive dressed in their bodysuit and tights with their hair done. Please do not send food or items of value with your dancer. Please ensure your dancer has a water bottle labelled with their name.

<u>All</u> dancers will be in **BOTH** performances. Our performances are Wednesday December 14 and Thursday December 15. Performances start at 6:30pm

The theatre doors open at 6:00pm

Please drop your dancer off at the studio no later than 6:00pm. **PLEASE NOTE:** Dancers who are 13 years of age or younger MUST be signed in and out by a parent/guardian. Your dancer should arrive dressed in their bodysuit and tights with their hair done. Younger dancers may bring a small quiet activity to keep them entertained in the studio (please no toys/items of value). Dancers may bring a small healthy snack (no nuts due to allergies). Please ensure your dancer has a water bottle labelled with their name.
